SFO's NBR subscription (CON0016681)

We refer to your enquiry on 5 January 2026 for the following information in relation to our group online NBR subscription:

"At any time between April 2022 and January 2026 did any individuals at the SFO, outside the premium group of individuals with paid subscriptions, have access to NBR content?"

You clarified that you are asking how many people were *provided with the option to access NBR content outside the number that had paid access* and if any, on what date was access given and to what articles/stories.

As you have used our website OIA request form, we have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA). As the matters about which you write are commercial and legal in nature, we ask that any NBR concerns about potential breach of copyright be raised with me directly in future.

Decision and response

The SFO has 78 employees and currently has a group NBR online subscription for 10 users. A process is underway to establish if we require additional subscriptions.

As you will appreciate, reporting by the NBR can be a useful source of intelligence and information to support the SFO's detection and law enforcement functions. We can confirm that, for these purposes only, 15 NBR articles have been shared by subscribers since April 2022 with a small number of staff involved in SFO operations:


